Notecards are 5x7, printed on white 80-lb acid-free cover stock, with UPC bar code on back. Each is packaged in a clear acetate sleeve with an opaque white, square-flap envelope.


➤ Wholesale cost \$1.75. Minimum order: 6 each style.


- ➤ **Small: Suggested retail price \$10.00.** 4x7 or 5x7 in 8x10 matte.


