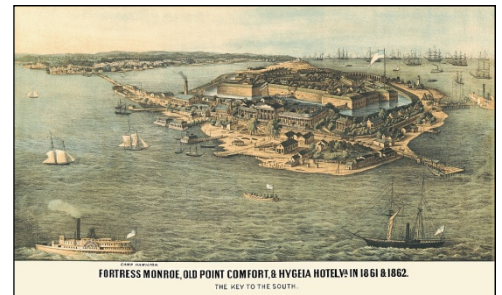

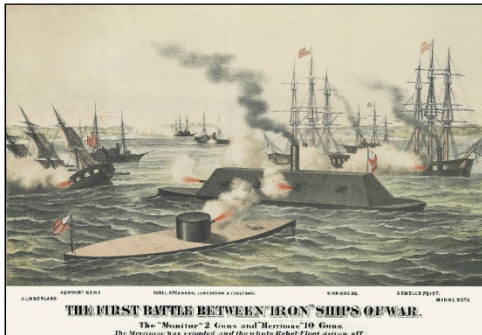

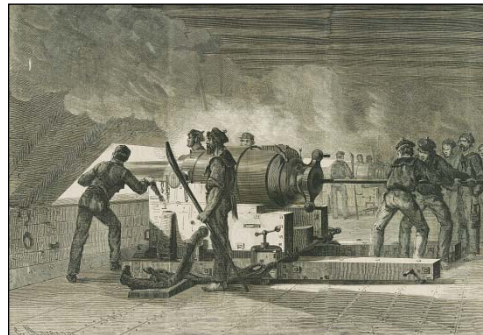

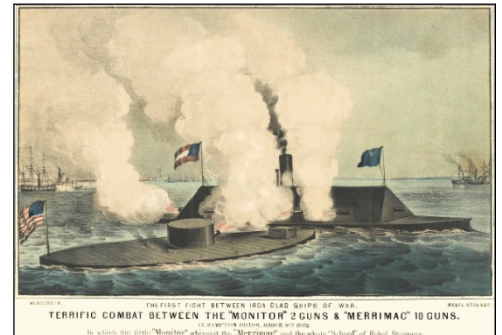

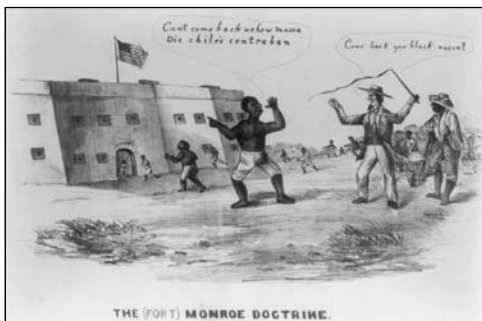
First Battle Between Iron Ships of War (1862) Card, 5x7, 7x10
